Activities report to YASC May 2023

Good morning Area! We have not had an event since last area so I do not have anything to report on that, but we are very excited for the speaker jam next weekend on May 21st!!!! Please help us by announcing this event and sharing with your friends! A few reminders to announce, side dishes are potluck so please bring something if you can and and bring your camping chair in case we run out of seats in the ramada! We will have our own kayak rentals as well, separate from whoever usually is doing it at the lake, for a suggested \$10 an hour. Also we will be having a raffle and auction and have received some awesome stuff especially from what Dave got for us at MACCNA, so bring cash!!! Please keep us posted if you know of a treatment center that is coming and how many so we can accurately plan for burgers/hot dogs! We cant wait to see you there!

As for our June event, we do have a major issue. Just Ask rentals has closed their doors and is not honoring our rental for the dunk tank. We have already printed and have the flyers going around for this event which have a big dunk tank on them. I have done my best to find a replacement but it has been tough. I found one finally and was given a quote that was more than 2 times what we were going to pay at just ask (which is just over \$150), after explaining the situation they were willing to come down from 415 or so to 300. This is unforeseen and not budgeted for. I did not plan to ask for extra funds for this event, but since we have already have the flyer out and people are excited about it, I am asking our area to allow us 100-150 extra in addition to our monthly budget on this event. 150 preferably since that is how much extra the rental will cost and are comfortable with the rest of the budget we've already set, but I think with at least the very least 100 we could hopefully still buy enough balloons for the water balloon fight and enough food for main dish. I know we are trying to have everything sent back to the groups, as we should, but this is time sensitive as I need to let the rental company know if we are keeping the reservation as soon as possible. If you guys are not willing to vote immediately, maybe we have GSRS let us know their groups votes within a few days via text to the secretary or something? I can not make the company wait until next area (1 week prior to the event) and cancel the reservation when they are willing to waive part of their fees because of our predicament. Thank you!!!! So we need our budget for June today.

Trent is reading my report, so I wont make him read this out loud as if it were him. As many of you already know, Bailey has another baby on the way! What this means for activities is that I will need a lot of extra help at the end of the year, especially at the campout. I will be 37 weeks pregnant at the campout. I will not be able to put on an event in October but will rely on the committee to make that happen. We are planning November and December events already as well!

As for July and August we have events in the works. We are searching for a locati9on for July as I have just found out our desired location is unavailable for our event.
