So , here is a summary of what has changed from beginning to end of 2023. The Eurmax canopy has a small broken piece but it can be help up with a little piece being placed in the arm. We are missing the bags for the cornhole sets, we gained a nylon chair through lost and found, we have 4 folding chairs with foot rests that are being accounted for. We bought some large plastic storage shelves on the day of the inventory to organize the storage unit. We lost the plastic NA sandwich board, the coffee maker was broken. We gained a sleeping bad in lost and found. We gained a projecter that was donated and a large screen that we purchased. Our Bingo games are missing a few balls. I am unsure of the notes on life jackets but it appears we lost a few life jackets. We gained a box of 3ft marshmallow sticks leftover purchase from the campout. Our PR and H&I stuff is in the storage unit. We gained all of the casino stuff listed. I'm pretty sure we got rid of expired/old seasonings. Im not entirely sure this list is accurate. We gained a lot of kitchen utensils, a brand new huge restaurant size pot and restaurant cutting board. We need plates and coffee cups before an event.

I think that sums it up. I recommend that we get a PA system. It is necessary at our events and would help better carry the message because people could actually hear. We had many events last year where the speaker could not be heard, including the May event where we rented a speaker and it still sucked. The one proposed would not have this issue. We also think two coffee makers, a new cash box with more slots , clip boards, cash bags, I think we need a new volleyball(?). Also two quality sets of cornhole with bags, Ask Aaron K for input on these. The cheap ones on Amazon will be the same quality and they are not great. We use them at many events and I think it would be a good investment for our activities.
