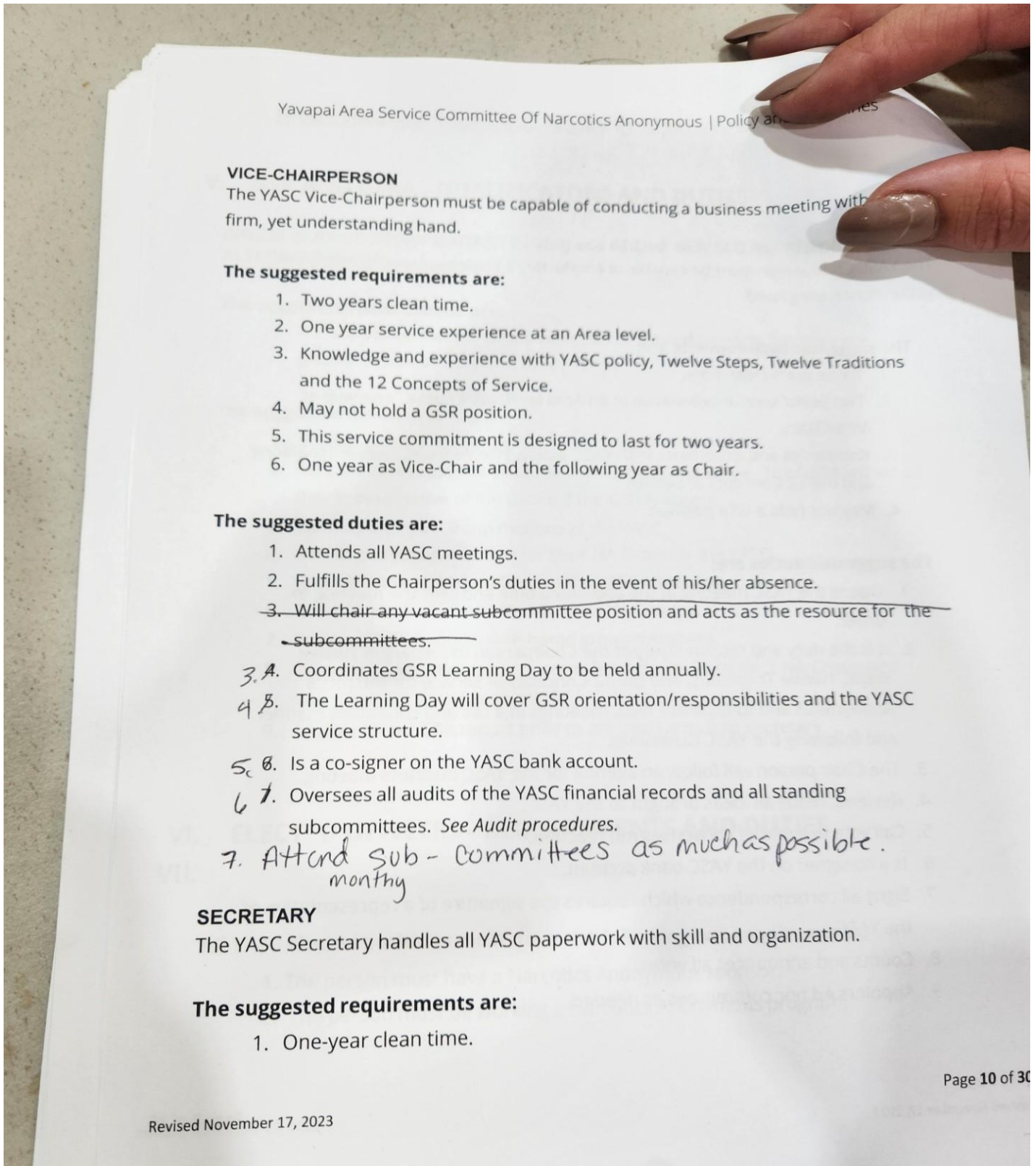
Old Business: Annette: Western Service-learning day October 17th-20th.
